Buckthorn Pull

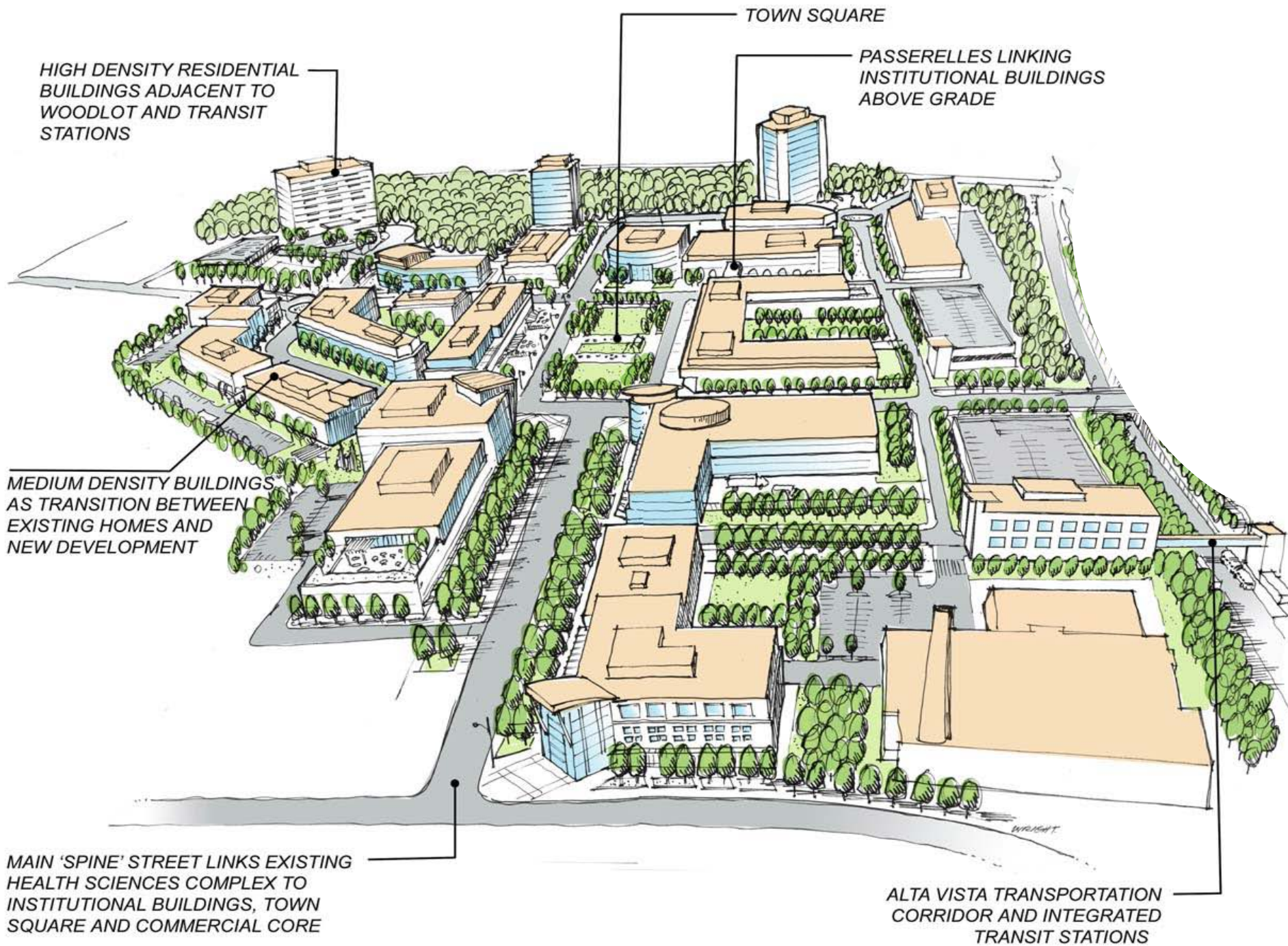
- work plan for this summer includes:
